- ❖ **Ethernet Adapter.** You'll want to Plug directly into your Internet through the Ethernet port to guarantee a high quality connection during your podcast interviews. If you don't have an Ethernet port in your computer, purchase an adapter.
- ❖ **Mics.** Go with what you can afford between the 4 options below. The packages come with a pop filter.
 - **Logitech Clearchat** (Budget)
 - **CAD U37** (Intermediate)
 - **Heil Sound PR40** (Studio Professional)
 - **Blue Yeti Mic** (What I Use)
- ❖ **Headphones.** Just make sure you're using these when you record. Apple headphones work fine, but you can purchase studio headphones if you'd like.
- ❖ **Software.** Below is the necessary software to record your podcasts.
 - **Skype**
 - **Call Recording** (Choose One)
 - Ecamm Recorder (Mac)
 - Pamela Recorder (Windows)
 - **Recording Software** (Choose One)
 - Garageband
 - Audacity
 - Adobe Audition
 - **Auphonic (set this up later)**
 - **Libsyn (set this up later)**
